## *What is the Trust?*

The Trust exists to safeguard the objects which form the collections of Lackham Museum of Agriculture and Rural Life based at Wiltshire College—Lackham. The Museum has been in existence since the original Lackham School of Agriculture first opened its doors to students in 1946. Over the years it has grown in size and function with many of the Museum displays now presented within historic farm buildings. The majority of the objects and indeed the buildings have been donated by supporters of the Museum.

Most recently the important rural life collections of the Wiltshire Life Society (formerly based at the Great Barn, Avebury) have moved to the Lackham site and the Society has now formally joined with the Friends of Lackham Museum to form this new Charitable Trust. In a unique partnership, the newly created Wiltshire College has generously agreed to manage the museum collections on behalf of the Trust and secure its long term future.
